Instructions for abstracts:

- Maximum lenght: 1000 caracters (about 250 words)
- Should not contain any figure or table.
- Must include the name, institution(s) that represent(s), specific activity inside the institution, country and e-mails of the author(s).
- Format: Document A4, type letter Arial 11, simple spaced, horizontal and vertical margins: 3 cm
- Additional Indication about the preference of the oral exposition and final poster of the abstract.
- If you have more than one work, send each one in individual applications.
- More than two abstracts per author or more than three co-author participations will not be allowed

TITTLE IN BOLD AND CAPITAL LETTERS

Surname and authors name (1); Surname and name (2)

- (1) Institution which belongs, specific activity in the institution
- (2) Institution which belongs, specific activity in the institution COUNTRY (capital) *E-mail* (cursive),

After two spaces, the abstract has to contain a maximum of 1000 characters, without any figure or table. The text must be complete justified and if it is possible, elaborated with MS-Word.
